### 04 Mayors Report

• Maggie (deputy mayor) and Doreen (Locum clerk) and me visited Broadland Council Offices in Norwich in September to source recycled office equipment. Due to the merge of Broadland District Council and South Norfolk District Council and their agreed move to Broadland Business Park in Thorpe they were offering the public and any organisations the opportunity to free office furniture. We have been able to resource our new office and obtain other furniture at the same time.

• Council is well on track to setting its precept budget for 2024-25. We have agreed to replace 30 streetlights units with new LED units to help reduce rising energy costs.

• Another key initiative from the budget draft is the allocation of £5000 for our local community organisations to apply for grants, further details will follow shortly.

• HSTF (High Street Task Force) The second meeting of this funded programme was held on Friday 6th October, at the Town Hall. The meeting was attended by various stakeholders across Norfolk, district, and parishes. Identified next steps to establish a Town's Team of key stakeholders to develop a vision for Stalham.

• Cllr Toone and I attended the road safety meeting at Nth Walsham High School where questions and discussion took place on road safety and the challenges parishes across North Norfolk regarding rural roads and speeding.

• Cllr Toone and myself have fenced off the seeded burial extension at Campingfield Road

• Thanks to Cllr Phil Hanton who has liaised with Stalham Town Football Club to ensure that they could be accommodated at the Recreation Ground during their refurbishment of their club house and increased numbers of teams.

• Cllr Toone and myself on behalf of the Trustees of SABRGC have submitted a grant application with the support of Active Norfolk for £10,000 to support people over 55 to become more active. The grant includes an Engagement Coordinator's role.

• Belated thanks to Cllr Phil Hanton and his wife Val for hosting a summer barbecue which was in recognition to Carolyn Gelinas and Mike Lilly for their service to Stalham as parish councillors. Unfortunately Mike was unable to attend on this occasion due to a fall.
